1. WORD: The habit of TIME WITH HIM, Acts 2:42

In His Word

"If you continue in my Word, then you are my disciples indeed. And you will know the

truth and the truth will set you free." John 8:31-32

In His Presence

"If you remain in me, and my words remain in you, then you will ask for anything you wish, and you shall have it ... in this way you become my disciples." John 15:7-8 (GN)

3. WITNESS: The Habit of Fellowship – a team relationship with others


"Love each other just as much as I love you. Your **strong love for each other** will prove to the world that you are my disciples."
